

ORDINANCE NO. 12

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING HUNTING ON PRIVATE PROPERTY, OR ENTERING THEREON FOR THIS PURPOSE OR FOR THE PURPOSE OF HUNTING ON ADJOINING PROPERTY WITHOUT FIRST HAVING OBTAINED THE WRITTEN CONSENT OF THE OWNER OR LESSEE THEREOF, AND PRESCRIBE PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.

Be it enacted and ordained by the Supervisors of the Township of Greene, County of Pike and State of Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by authority of the same:

S E C T I O N I

No person shall henceforth enter upon any private property not his own within the Township of Greene, Pike County, Pennsylvania, for the purpose of hunting thereon, nor shall any person enter thereon with firearms in his possession with the intent to hunt thereon or on adjoining property, nor shall any person hunt thereon, unless he first shall have obtained from the owner or lessee of said property permission in writing to do so, dated and signed by said owner or lessee.

S E C T I O N II

Unless the aforesaid written permission provides for a shorter period, said written permission shall be valid for a period not exceeding thirty-five days from the date of said written instrument.

S E C T I O N III

Any person engaged in any of the aforesaid activities shall have said written permission on his person at all times while so engaged, and, upon demand by any constable of the

township or other peace officer' shall produce the same.

S E C T I O N I V

Any person who shall violate any of the provisions of this Ordinance, shall upon conviction thereof, be sentenced to pay a fine of one hundred (\$100.00) dollars for each offense and costs of prosecution, and upon default of such payment of fine and costs to imprisonment for a period not exceeding thirty days.

S E C T I O N V

This Ordinance is adopted pursuant to the authority contained in clauses XXV and XLVII of section 702 of the Act of May 1, 1933, P.L. 103, as amended and supplemented, 53PS sections 65741 and 65747.
