ORDINANCE NO. 71

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE COMPENSATION OF SUPERVISORS OF GREENE TOWNSHIP, PIKE COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

The following ordinance is hereby adopted by the Board of Supervisors of Greene Township:

Whereas, The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania has enacted a Second Class Township Code, setting forth in Section 606 certain guidelines and limitations for the compensation of supervisors of townships of the second class; and

WHEREAS, said Code provides that supervisors of townships having a population of 4,999 shall be compensated in an amount not to exceed \$1,875 annually; and

WHEREAS, the population of Greene Township is below 4,999; and

WHEREAS, the General Assembly by said Act authorizes the boards of supervisors of the various townships of the second class to determine the compensation of supervisors, subject to the limitations set forth in that Act; and

WHEREAS, it is the intention of the Board of Supervisors of Greene Township to set compensation for supervisors on a permeeting basis and within the limitations of the said Township Code:

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby enacted and ordained as follows:

- Each supervisor of Greene Township elected or appointed to office on or after the general election of November, 1999 shall receive compensation for attending duly advertised general or special public meetings of the board of supervisors at the rate of One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars for each meeting attended by each supervisor.
- No supervisors shall receive annual compensation under this ordinance in excess of the annual statutory limit set by the General Assembly in the said Township Code for supervisors within the applicable population category.
- 3. No supervisor shall be compensated for attending any meetings of the board of supervisors in excess of 19 meetings per year (the 19th meeting to be compensated at \$75.00 rather than \$100.00). However, the absence of compensation once the statutory limit is reached shall not in any way affect or negate such supervisor's duty

or obligation to attend such uncompensated meetings or perform the required duties of a supervisor.

- 4. The compensation for supervisors under this ordinance shall be paid monthly.
- 5. This ordinance shall become effective five (5) days from the date of enactment, or as soon thereafter as provided and permitted by law.
