IMPORTANT:

It is the applicant's responsibility to have all property corners and property side lines correctly identified and visibly marked to verify well placement on property. Sewage disposal areas and septic tanks must also be identified. In no instance is Greene Township or its permit officer responsible for improper well location. Well permits will only be issued to lots that have a legally installed sewage system.

Applicant shall complete Part 1 of application and drilling contractor information in Part 2. Attach plot plan or sketch identifying property lines, septic area and septic tank, dwelling, and location of proposed well. The sketch must also demonstrate that the proposed well location is at least 50 feet from any neighboring septic tanks and 100 feet minimum from any neighboring sewage absorption areas (as well as your own). Include distances in feet to the above-named features. Forward with a check payable to Greene Township for \$150.00 to:
