Pike County Hazard Mitigation Plan Municipal Adoption Resolution

Resolution No. 22-12 Greene Township, Pike County, Pennsylvania

WHEREAS, the Greene Township, Pike County, Pennsylvania, is most vulnerable to natural and humanmade hazards, which may result in loss of life and property, economic hardship, and threats to public health and safety, and

WHEREAS, Section 322 of the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 (DMA 2000) requires state and local governments to develop and submit for approval to the President a mitigation plan that outlines processes for identifying their respective natural hazards, risks, and vulnerabilities, and

WHEREAS, the Greene Township acknowledges the requirement of Section 322 of DMA 2000 to have an approved Hazard Mitigation Plan as a prerequisite to receiving post-disaster Hazard Mitigation Grant Program funds, and

WHEREAS, the Pike County Hazard Mitigation Plan has been developed by Pike County Office of Community Planning in cooperation with other County departments, and officials and citizens of Greene Township, and

WHEREAS, a public involvement process consistent with the requirements of DMA 2000 was conducted to develop the Pike County Hazard Mitigation Plan, and

WHEREAS, the Pike County Hazard Mitigation Plan recommends mitigation activities that will reduce losses to life and property affected by both natural and human-made hazards that face the County and its municipal governments,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the governing body for the Greene Township:

- The 2022 Pike County Hazard Mitigation Plan is hereby adopted as the official Hazard Mitigation Plan of the Greene Township, and
- The 2022 Pike County Hazard Mitigation Plan is hereby adopted as a part of the Pike County Comprehensive Plan, and
- The respective officials and agencies identified in the implementation strategy of the 2022
 Pike County Hazard Mitigation Plan are hereby directed to implement the recommended
 activities assigned to them.
