RESOLUTION 23-13

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF GREENE, PIKE COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA ESTABLISHING POLICIES FOR THE SALE AND DISPOSAL OF PERSONAL PROPERTY.

WHEREAS, Greene Township ("Township") from time to time finds itself with excess personal property that is no longer of use to the Township; and

WHEREAS, the Pennsylvania Second Class Township Code allows the Board of Supervisors to sell or dispose of unneeded personal property and established procedures for the sale or disposition of such property; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Greene wishes to delegate the responsibility for the sale or disposition of unneeded personal property to the Board of Supervisors;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of Greene Township, Pike County, as follows:

- 1. The Board of Supervisors of Greene Township shall have the responsibility for determining when personal property is no longer needed by the Township by a majority vote at a public meeting.
- 2. When the Board of Supervisors determines that the Township no longer needs personal property, they shall determine fair market value and sell or dispose of the personal property in accordance with the regulations of the Pennsylvania Second Class code.
- 3. With respect to personal property, either individual items or lots of items, where the fair market value of which is estimated to be less than two thousand dollars (\$2,000.00), the Board of Supervisors may sell or dispose of the item or items as they believe best serves the interests of the Township. This shall include an advertisement in a newspaper of general circulation which may include a sealed bidding process and advertisement on the Township website.
