

RESOLUTION 23-14

Be it resolved and enacted that, at the regular meeting of the Board of Supervisors of Greene Township, Pike County, Pennsylvania on November 1, 2023, the following Short-Term Rental Permit Application Fee Schedule be adopted by Resolution 23-14.

SHORT-TERM RENTAL PERMIT APPLICATION FEES

Initial Permit Application Fees

An application for a short-term rental permit shall be accompanied by an initial fee. Initial fees are prorated quarterly based upon date of submittal.

<u>Bureau Veritas</u>	\$500
<u>Greene Township Sewage Enforcement Officer Inspection</u> – includes 1 inspection.....	\$200
<i>Each additional inspection may incur additional fees.</i>	
<i>If additional sewage permits are deemed applicable, their associated fees are also applicable per Resolution 20-3</i>	
<u>Greene Township Administration</u>	\$100

Renewal Fees


An annual renewal fee shall be established below, which permit holders shall pay when renewing their permit issued pursuant to Ordinance #99 – Short-Term Rental Ordinance. Failure to pay the renewal fee by February 15th will result in the assessment of a fee twice the amount of the normal renewal fee. If the fee is not paid by May 1st, the permit shall be null and void and application for a new permit, not a renewal, shall be required.

<u>Bureau Veritas</u>	\$500
<u>Greene Township Sewage Enforcement Officer Inspection</u>	\$200
<u>Greene Township Administration</u>	\$100

**All initial and renewal fees payable by check to Bureau Veritas. Properties connected to Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection permitted sewage treatment plants and facilities will not require inspection by the Sewage Enforcement Officer.*
