RESOLUTION NO. 24-3

**RESOLUTION TO LEVY TAX TO SUPPORT AMBULANCE, RESCUE AND
OTHER EMERGENCY SERVICES SERVING THE TOWNSHIP**

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Greene Township, Pike County (the “Supervisors”) is the governing body of Greene Township (the “Township”), a municipal corporation operating under the PA Second Class Township Code, 53 P.S. Section 65101 et seq. (hereinafter the “Township Code”); and,

WHEREAS, the Township Code, Section 3205, 53 P.S. Section 68205, provides that the Township may establish a property tax, not to exceed one-half mill, to support ambulance, rescue and other emergency services that serve the Township; and,

WHEREAS, the Supervisors recognize the necessity of providing ambulance, rescue and other emergency services to the residents and members of the public situated within the Township; and,

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors has also been informed of the financial constraints placed upon volunteer ambulance, rescue and other emergency services within the Township; and,

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors has determined that in order to provide emergency ambulance services in the Township, it is in the Township’s best interest to

establish a regular revenue source for providing financial support to the ambulance services that are serving the Township.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it Resolved and Enacted by the Board of Supervisors of Greene Township, hereby resolved as follows:

1. The recitals set forth above are hereby incorporated into the provisions of this Resolution.
2. The Supervisors hereby levy a tax of one-half mill on all real property within the Township made taxable for township purposes, as ascertained by the last adjusted valuation for county purposes.
3. The tax to be levied pursuant to this Resolution shall only be used support ambulance, rescue and other emergency services that serve the Township, with the restriction that the tax funds shall only be used for vehicles, equipment, repairs and certain supplies.

This Resolution is hereby adopted this 7th day of February, 2024, and shall become effective February 7, 2024.
