

Resolution 24-6

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF GREENE, PIKE COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA ESTABLISHING OPEN COMMUNICATION BETWEEN THE SHORT-TERM RENTAL ENFORCEMENT OFFICER AND THE TOWNSHIP SOLICITOR.

WHEREAS, Greene Township, Pike County, Pennsylvania requires an enforcement officer to enforce the rules and regulations set forth in the Short-Term Rental Ordinance; and,

WHEREAS, in order to properly perform the duties of the Short-Term Rental Ordinance enforcement, the enforcement officer must have access to legal advice; and,

WHEREAS, the township solicitor may charge for his/her time and bill the township accordingly;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the enforcement officer who is appointed to perform the enforcement of the Short-Term Rental Ordinance, adopted by the Greene Township, Pike County, Pennsylvania Board of Supervisors, shall have an open line of communication between him/herself and the appointed township solicitor in order to obtain legal advice to carry out enforcement of said ordinance.
