A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF GREENE, PIKE COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA ESTABLISHING POLICIES FOR NOTICE OF TREE REMOVAL TO ABUTTING PROPERTY OWNERS.

WHEREAS, the Pennsylvania Second Class Township Code requires the Board of Supervisors to notify abutting property owners of the proposed removal of trees having a trunk diameter in excess of six inches from the road right-of-way;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of Greene Township, Pike County, will provide written notice to abutting property owners in the form of a letter mailed to the mailing address provided on the Pike County GIS map in order to provide adequate time for property owners to submit a written request for logs, cordwood, branch wood or other forms of wood derived from the destruction or removal of any trees growing along the highways to be surrendered for disposal to the township. If no request is submitted by property owners, the township will leave such logs, cordwood, branch wood or other forms of wood on the property.
