

Resolution 26-4  
STATE OF EMERGENCY PROCLAMATION  
GREENE TOWNSHIP, PIKE COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

WHEREAS, a severe winter storm has impacted Greene Township, Pike County, Pennsylvania, bringing heavy snowfall, ice accumulation, freezing temperatures, and dangerous road and travel conditions; and

WHEREAS, these conditions pose an imminent threat to the safety, health, and welfare of residents, visitors, and property within Greene Township; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to declare a state of emergency to ensure the safety of all persons and property and to facilitate necessary emergency response and recovery efforts;

NOW, THEREFORE, we, the Greene Township Board of Supervisors, do hereby declare and proclaim as follows:

A State of Emergency is hereby declared within Greene Township, Pike County, Pennsylvania, effective immediately, due to the severe winter storm.

All residents are urged to remain indoors, avoid unnecessary travel, and exercise extreme caution if travel is unavoidable.

This proclamation authorizes the activation of emergency response agencies, including police, fire, public works, and emergency medical services, to coordinate efforts for rescue, relief, and recovery.

This declaration shall remain in effect until such time as the emergency conditions no longer exist, or until terminated by further proclamation.
