

RESOLUTION 26-5

Greene Township, Pike County, Pennsylvania

APPOINTING AN ALTERNATE EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT COORDINATOR

WHEREAS, Greene Township recognizes the vital importance of effective emergency management and preparedness to ensure the safety, health, and welfare of its residents; and

WHEREAS, the Pennsylvania Emergency Management Services Code (35 Pa.C.S. §§ 7501 et seq.) encourages local governments to recommend qualified individuals for appointment as emergency management officials; and

WHEREAS, Greene Township wishes to formally recommend Mr. Dave Altemier for appointment by the Pike County Emergency Management Coordinator as the Township's Alternate Emergency Management Coordinator to assist and support the primary Emergency Management Coordinator in overseeing and coordinating emergency management efforts within the Township.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Greene Township Board of Supervisors as follows:

1. The Greene Township Board of Supervisors hereby recommends that the Pike County Emergency Management Coordinator consider the appointment of Mr. Dave Altemier as the Alternate Emergency Management Coordinator for Greene Township.
2. The Township believes Mr. Altemier possesses the necessary qualifications, experience, and dedication to serve effectively in this role, supporting emergency preparedness, response, recovery, and mitigation activities.
3. The Township respectfully requests the Pike County Emergency Management Coordinator to give favorable consideration to this recommendation and to take any necessary steps to appoint Mr. Altemier as the Alternate Emergency Management Coordinator for Greene Township.
4. The Township hereby transmits this recommendation to the Pike County Emergency Management Coordinator for consideration.
